Abstract:

The long term growth rate outlook for butadiene is higher than the expected growth in supply of butadiene from steam cracking, but the differential is small, and the volume of dehydrogenation capacity already built in China appears sufficient, if necessary at some point in the future. The high butadiene prices in 2011 triggered a number of investments to exploit mixed C4s which were previously not captured, and this has effectively postponed the date at which prices will rise to the level necessary to make butylene dehydrogenation economical. The slump in natural rubber prices continued during 2015, and has maintained substitution pressure on SBR and BR, curtailing butadiene demand growth. There remains scope for major butadiene plants in Saudi Arabia, which could collect C4 streams from the numerous steam crackers there, and possibly also those in neighboring countries. However, these developments are believed to be on hold due to the current low butadiene prices, but are expected to happen when the butadiene market becomes tight, and will therefore serve to postpone any further developments of butane or butylene dehydrogenation capacity.

Global Butadiene Demand, 2015-e *Million tons*


