Abstract:

Global styrene consumption grew to 29 million tons in 2016. Growth in recent years has been flat as modest recovery in North America and Western Europe is in contrast to slowing growth in China and contraction in South American and Eastern European markets.

Polystyrene, the main end-use for styrene, accounting for 37 percent of styrene demand in 2016 has shown minimal growth since 2000, as a result of inter-polymer competition, consumer behaviour changes and technology development. Polystyrene continues to be challenged by competition from other polymers and feedstock costs, thus the growth outlook for polystyrene remains modest and below global GDP. Styrene demand into polystyrene is forecast to grow with a CAGR of around one percent from 2016-2025.

Global styrene consumption is forecast to grow at an average annual rate of around two percent through 2035. The high growth areas, ABS, EPS and SBR, are all forecast to grow at rates of around two to three percent.

Global Styrene Demand, 2016


